



Rules and Regulations

1. All participants must submit their entries and payment online through this website:
<http://www.nikerunning.com.my/nikecity10k>
2. All entries are based on a first-come first-serve basis unless otherwise stated.
3. Registration for the event is open to all participants 16 years old and above as of 10 Oct 2010. Participants below the age of 18 years as of 10 Oct 2010 are required to obtain the written consent of their parent/guardian.
4. Once the registration form has been duly processed, there will be NO REFUND of entry fees for those who, for whatever reason, eventually do not take part.
5. Completion of the registration form is an indication of the participant's agreement to abide by the rules and regulations of the Nike City 10K Kuala Lumpur.
6. Participants are eligible to take part in the following categories:
 - 5km
 - Men's & Women's Under 25 Category (24 years old and below as of 10 Oct 2010)
 - Men's & Women's Open Category (Open to all participants 16 years old and above as of 10 Oct 2010)
 - School Challenge Cat. A (Secondary Schools)
 - School Challenge Cat. B (Universities)
 - 10km
 - Men's & Women's Under 25 Category (24 years old and below as of 10 Oct 2010)
 - Men's & Women's Open Category (Open to all participants 16 years old and above as of 10 Oct 2010)
 - School Challenge Cat. A (Secondary Schools)
 - School Challenge Cat. B (Universities)
7. Entry fee is as follows:
RM10 (24 years old and below as of 10 Oct 2010)
RM50 (25 years old and above as of 10 Oct 2010)
8. The school in each category that accumulates the total longest distance combined during the Nike City 10K race will win within the cut off time. The School Team Challenge cut-off timings are: 1 hour for 5km and 2 hours for 10km.
9. For the school team challenge prize money and vouchers, the organizers will contact the school teacher in-charge / head of department to hand over the prizes for dissemination of prizes to the school runners.
10. Race entry is not transferable. Those who are found running with an unauthorized race tee will be disqualified.
11. All participants must bring along this confirmation slip or confirmation number together with their Identity Card or passport to collect their D-Tag (timing device) and runner's tee at the Race Pack Collection.
12. The Nike City 10K Kuala Lumpur race tee must be worn at all times during the race. No running with bare torso is allowed or without the Nike City 10K Kuala Lumpur race event tee. Failure to comply will result in the

runners' disqualification from the race. Officials reserve the right to prevent a participants' continuation in the race should they fail to comply.

13. Change in sizes during collection of the race event tee is strictly NOT allowed. Participants must adhere to the race event tee sizes that they have registered for.

14. Participants must run on the designated path for the entire route. Failure to do so will result in disqualification.

15. Participants who are walking are required to keep to the left side of the lane so as not to cause obstruction to other runners.

16. No pets or any form of wheel-run objects of transport e.g. inline skates, prams, push cars, shoes with built-in or attached rollers are allowed on the course other than official race and medical vehicles.

17. The race route on the event day will be closed to traffic up to 3 hours after the publicized race start time after which the road closure will be lifted. Participants will then be allowed to continue on the footpath at their own risk.

18. Whilst every reasonable precaution will be taken by the Organizers to ensure the participants' safety, participants partake in this event at their own risks and the Organizers, their sponsors and their appointed officials shall not be liable for any death or injury, loss or damage, suffered or otherwise and howsoever arising.

19. The Organizers' reserve the right to remove any participant deemed physically incapable of continuing with the race to prevent him/her from causing greater harm and injury to himself/herself.

20. The Organizers reserve the right to delay the commencement of the race in the event of inclement weather. Should the inclement weather persist after delay, the Organizers reserve the right to cancel the race without any refund.

21. The Organizer shall not be responsible for any disputes arising from incomplete entry details.

22. The Organizers reserve the right to limit and refuse entries without assigning any reasons thereof.

23. The Organizers reserve the right to amend the Rules and Regulations without giving prior notification or any reasons thereof.

24. The Organizers reserves the right to provide winners with attire to be worn on the winner's podium. Winners will have to wear the given attire; failure to do so may result in disqualification.

25. For disputes on race results, only appeals in writing submitted to the organizers 30 minutes after the official results announcement will be accepted. A deposit of RM50 will be refunded if the appeal is successful. The Organizer's decision will be final.

26. Any disputes arising from participation in the Nike City 10K Kuala Lumpur shall be referred to Arbitration to be conducted in Malaysia within the Laws of Malaysia.

27. The Organizer reserves the right to use any photographs (including those of participants), motion pictures, recordings, or any other record of this event for any legitimate purpose, including commercial advertising.
